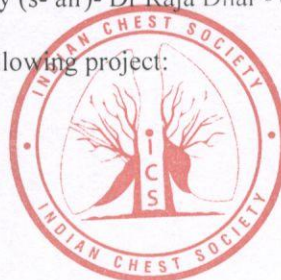
6. Research activities of Indian Chest Society – Dr. D J Christopher

Dr. D J Christopher informed that the ongoing research projects were reviewed, and the old inactive projects were cleaned up from the list. The following are the active ongoing projects:

1. Title: Diagnostic value of Endobronchial Ultrasound Transbronchial Needle Aspiration (EBUS TBNA) in management of mediastinal adenopathy in Indian Settings-Dr. Prashant Chhajed
2. Indiper-PE registry: Dr Sharma -is recruiting briskly
3. Title: Sleep- Apnoea Indian Registry (s- air)- Dr Raja Dhar - ongoing

The new approval has been given for the following project:

PI: Dr. Vijay Hadda



Title: Deciphering the role of bronchoalveolar lavage based immune cells transcriptomics in Non-Specific Interstitial Pneumonia (NSIP).

Status: Approved. Requesting the payment of grant.

He then explained how the research committee has agreed on a COI Document. The scope of which was as follows:

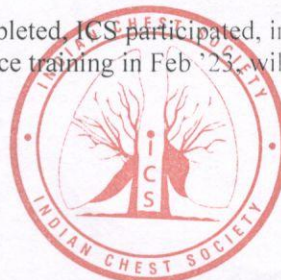
- To addresses the policies related to COI and Code of Ethics, to ensure integrity in decision making and to minimize bias
- Conflict of Interest means "any interest which could significantly prejudice an individual's objectivity in the decision-making process,
- It reassures grant applicants that the process followed for awarding grants is transparent and non-discriminatory.

COI -Defn:

- *Conflict of Interest means "any interest which could significantly prejudice an individual's objectivity in the decision-making process, thereby creating an unfair competitive advantage for the individual or the organization which he/she represents".*
- Major areas:
 - Interpersonal
 - Institutional
 - Financial gain
- Those with COI will not take part in the assessment of the project.
- The Reviewers and the Members of the Committee shall safeguard the confidentiality of all discussions and decisions taken during the process and shall refrain from discussing the same with any applicant or a third party.
- The committee members have voluntarily agreed not to submit any project as PI for funding in the first 2 yrs.
- Web site plans:
 - We hope to open a portal in ICS web site
 - 2 templates have been prepared & sent to go online:
 - Observational trials
 - Interventional trials

He also announced that the ICS has tied up with the ATS to jointly run the MECOR programme. ICS is already part of the programme, starting from the batch selected this year, for commencement of training in 2023. There has been a good response from the members, it is hope that more would befit in the coming years. The meeting attendees appreciated this. The salient details are as follows,

- MOA Signed in Aug:
 - Course director Dr DJ Christopher
 - Core Faculty: Dr Vijay Hadda & Dr Uma Maheshwari
- Research committee has committed to run it
- The call for application to the MECOR India programme commencing 2023 from 1 to 30 Sept 22
- Selection of candidates completed, ICS participated, in the selection
- The first batch will commence training in Feb '23, will be hosted at St John's medical college, Bangalore



7. State Chapters of Indian Chest Society – Dr. Jai Kumar Samaria

Dr. Gopi Chand Khilnani requested the zonal heads to inform the members about the activities in their states.

North Zone: Dr. Rakesh Chawla informed that they had successfully done RESPICON in Delhi under the aegis of the ICS as soon as the COVID ban was lifted. It was a great success. There were also many other events and webinars that have happened in the north zone.

South Zone: Repeated meetings on Asthma and Interventional Pulmonology have been happening with Yashoda group under the aegis of ICS. Dr. Kandi Subhakar informed that there were many state activities which were held which were successful and the zone is doing well. He has reported these details in the newsletter RESPIRE.



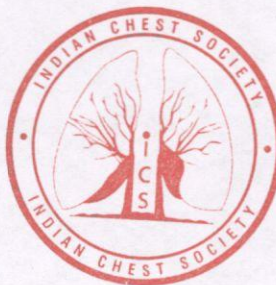

The next hearing is on Nov 24,2022 & ICS Governing Body in charge will wait for HC order on the issue.

2) During the AGM an unauthorized person was caught taking signature of attendees. His presence was unauthorized and what he was performing was illegal. He was pulled up and he did not initially identify himself. His register was confiscated.


